Vision

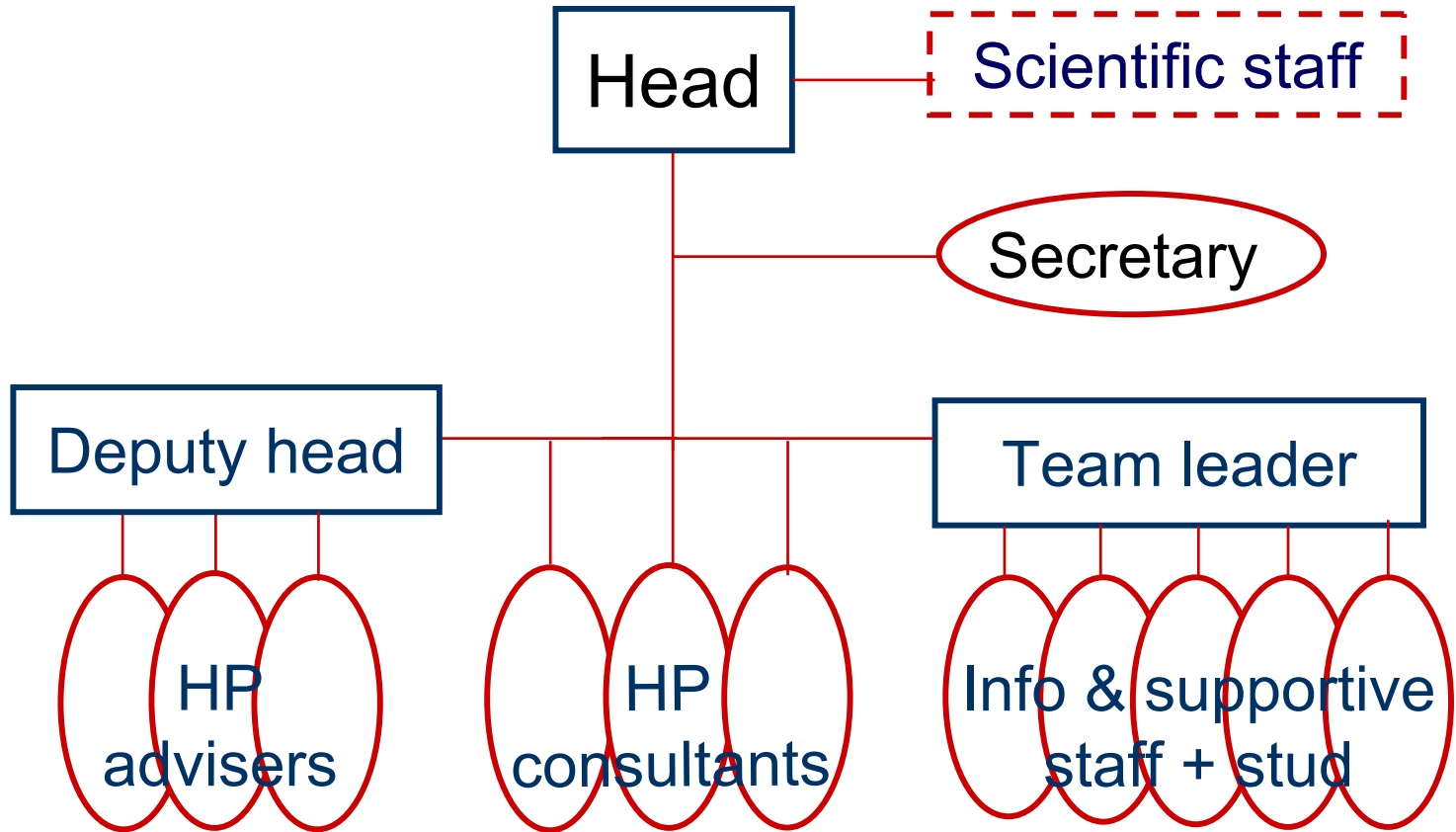
- To become a powerful cooperating partner by

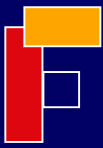
